GENERAL POLICY INFORMATION

Please read and inform your group of these policies below

Food and Beverage: Concession Stands are conveniently located in the lobby. Please note that food and beverage items may NOT be brought into the theatre from outside sources. Please dispose of any items before entering.

Audience Courtesy: We wish for every guest to have a wonderful, unforgettable experience during their visit. To provide that assurance, we ask that all noise making devices are turned off (cell phones, pagers, wristwatch alarms) and that, when possible, our guests remain seated during all productions, keeping chatter to a very minimal level. Candy wrappers and other noises made by food or beverage consumption can also be a distraction, so we ask that you keep this mind during the show.

Late arrivals: Performance times are printed on all Shubert tickets. Latecomers will be seated at the discretion of the management. Due to the policy of the individual show's producer, you may be asked to wait in the back of the theater for a short time. If you are asked to wait in the lobby, a large screen TV is available for you to view the performance.

Smoking: City Ordinance prohibits public smoking in all areas of the Theater.

Cameras and Video Recordings: Most performers and shows do not allow any duplication of their performances; therefore cameras and visual and audio recorders are prohibited in the Shubert Theatre.

Age Requirements: All patrons, regardless of age must have a ticket to enter the theater. Children under three and babes in arms WILL NOT BE PERMITTED into the theater except when otherwise indicated - please call the Shubert Box Office for details. 203.562.5666.
