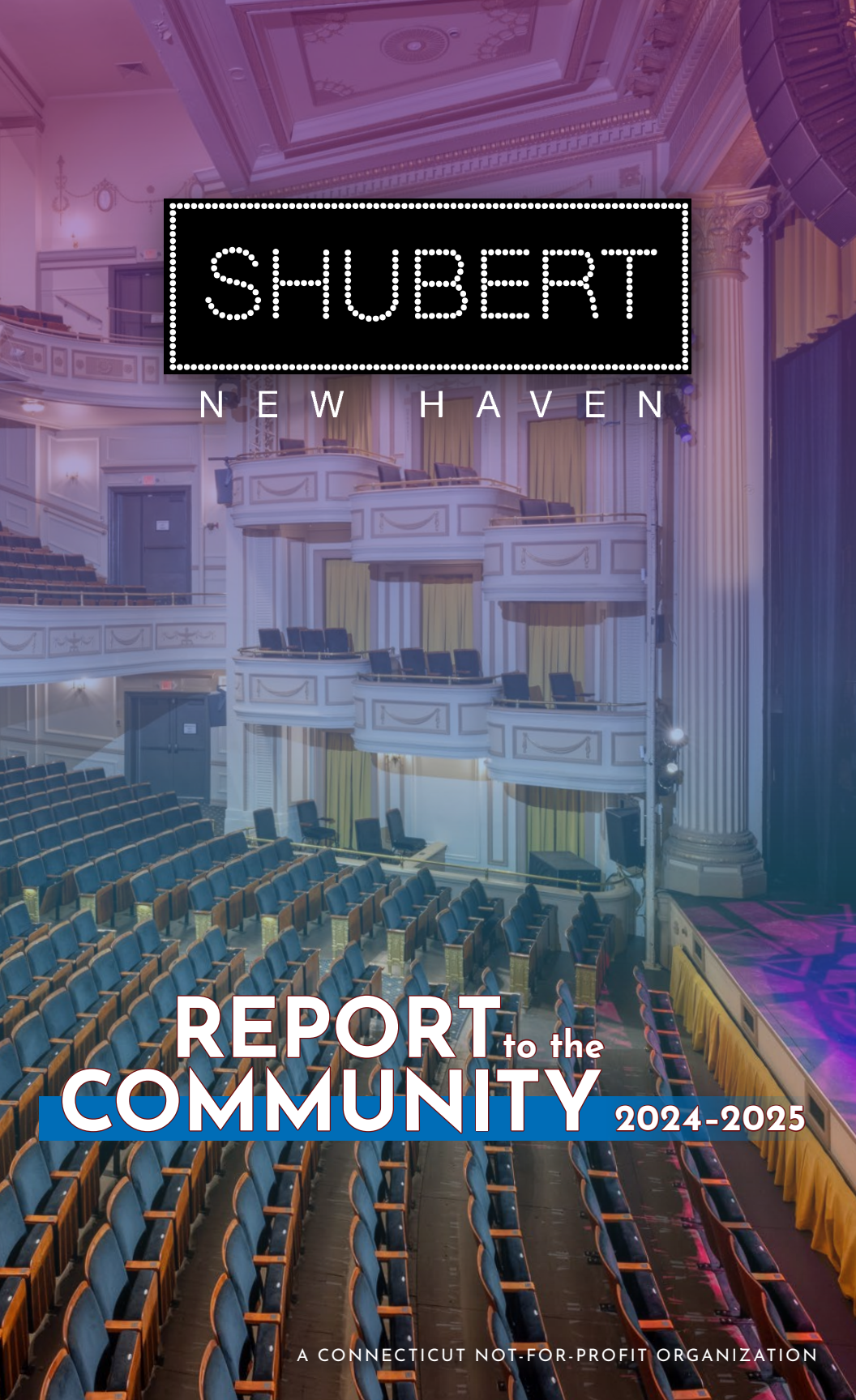

Dear FRIENDS of the SHUBERT

We are thrilled to share some exciting accomplishments we achieved during our 110th Anniversary Season. Our Broadway series brought a lineup of shows never before seen on the Shubert Stage. From the stories of extraordinary musical icons to fresh adaptations of blockbuster hits, these performances brought diverse perspectives from different cultures and varieties of artistic expression. Beyond Broadway, we furthered our mission to connect cultures by bringing in programming from all over the world with our new Rhythm and Grooves series including MOMIX, Rhythm India and Cirque Kalabanté.

In January of 2025, we debuted our brand-new state-of-the-art Elm City's Cabaret, creating a space to break down financial barriers and provide a smaller venue for local artists and a platform to help amplify their voices. For the third consecutive year we presented our Elm City's Finest series, but for the first time as three separate performances, each focused on a particular genre: spoken word, comedy and jazz, with all three shows playing to sold-out houses. This series featured 16 paid artists from Greater New Haven.

We continue to champion the importance of access to the arts by deepening our connection to our city with our continued expansion of our arts education and outreach programs. Last season we reached over 13,000 students by bringing diverse stories from our stage directly to children and families in the community, and thousands more to our theatre, with most programs offered for free.

Your unwavering support has been instrumental in the success and transformative impact the Shubert Theatre continues to have to foster positive change through the arts. Thank you for celebrating with us during our 110th Anniversary Season at the Shubert Theatre, where arts and community come together!

FINANCIAL HIGHLIGHTS

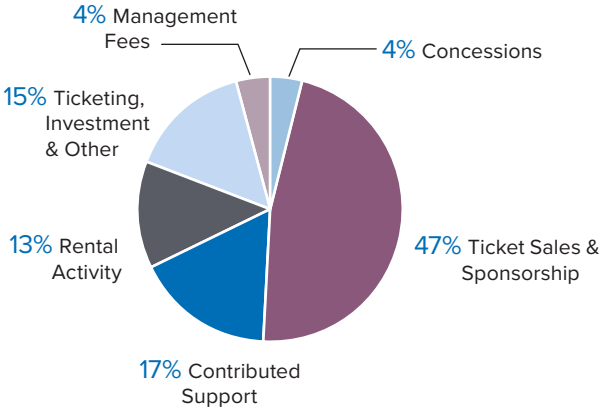
July 1, 2024–June 30, 2025

Payroll & Related Expense and Artistic Programming comprise 69% of operating expenditures for Fiscal 2025. In addition to the theatre's administrative staff, the Shubert's programming creates employment for a large number of local union stage workers, box office staff, ushers and other event-related part-time positions.

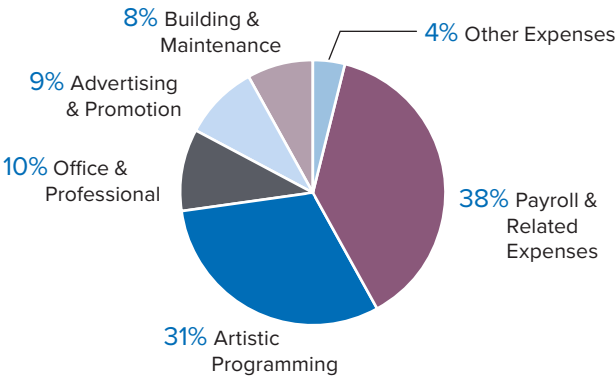
The revenue ratio was 83% earned and 17% contributed operating revenue in Fiscal 2025. Ticket Sales & Sponsorship comprised over half of earned operating revenue at \$3.5M.

Mission related programs and services accounted for 82% of operating expenditures in Fiscal 2025. Administrative and fundraising expenses accounted for 13% and 5% of expenses, respectively.

ELM CITY'S CABARET



During the 2024-2025 season we unveiled our brand-new state-of-the-art cabaret space – Elm City's Cabaret.

The creation of this new venue at the Shubert is a direct result of the State of Connecticut's Community Investment Fund 2030 (CIF) awarded to the "Shubert Theatre Sustainability" projects. The grant made it possible for us to transform the existing open lobby mezzanine into a new, enclosed multi-functional "cabaret-style" theatre to accommodate smaller productions and expand programming options for the Shubert. In addition, this much-needed professional space will provide the opportunity for local artists to present their works in a more intimate environment and at a more affordable rate than a performance on the venue's main stage. In its first season, Elm City's Cabaret put the spotlight on performances like Broadway in Love, Sounds of April and Randall, the popular Unc and Neph & Friends, Paint and Sip events, FREE Indie Lens Screenings and Free Trivia Nights.

For the third consecutive year we brought back our Elm City's Finest series, but for the first time as three separate performances in the new cabaret space, each focused on a particular artistic medium. This vibrant public art series included shows focused on Spoken Word, Comedy and Jazz, and all three performances were sold out. The new cabaret space and Shubert Theatre's commitment to providing artists with a new and historic platform to help amplify their voices allowed us to feature 16 paid artists from the local community of Greater New Haven.
